Berwick Heights Ladies Group (BHLG)

The emphasis of the BHLG is to provide a fun, friendly, and helpful ladies golf environment while promoting the Rules of Golf. We welcome all experience levels and ensure new golfers feel comfortable and at home. Ladies Group players must have a full membership (weekdays or full week).

Annual registration fee is \$30 and covers the prizes awarded throughout the season.

Play will commence every Thursday at 9:00am typically starting the first week of May and ending the last week of September. Players have no obligation to golf every week of the season, so they must sign up at the Pro Shop each week by noon Wednesday. Group members should arrive at the golf course no later than 8:30am. Group members have the option to play 9 or 18 holes and to walk or use a power cart.

Play begins with a shotgun start on holes 16, 17, 18, and 1 depending on the number of participants. Those playing only 9 holes need to record scores for holes 1 thru 9 regardless of their starting hole.

Two or three Nine and Dine events are held every year and are open to all female players.

OVERVIEW: The Fraser's Cup is a Fraser's Pro Home Centre and Berwick Heights Golf Course initiative to get golfers from various clubs (Berwick Heights, Paragon, Eden, Greenwood/Eagle Crest) across the Annapolis Valley to engage in a Ryder Cup style (Stroke play) competition. Courses will enter 12 golfers representing their respective course in a 2-day Gross competition.

The 2023 event was scheduled for September 2023 but was cancelled due to weather and will be held on Sunday, May 26, 2024 at Berwick Heights Golf Course with the team that qualified in 2023.

The 2024 edition of the Fraser's Cup will be held at Berwick Heights Golf Course on Saturday, September 21 and Sunday, September 22, 2024.

QUALIFICATION: The 2024 Berwick Heights Team qualifications are:

- Top 5 scores from the Men's Club Championship from the White Tees.
- Top 5 points leaders from the season long Road to the Fraser's Cup who did not already qualify from the Men's Club Championship. Points are accumulated through Men's Day, Men's Club Championship and Match Play.
- Two Captain's picks will be decided by the Club Champion (Team Captain) and the General Manager.

Support our club by signing up for the Club Championship and our other events to accumulate points and let's put a solid team together for this event.
